

## Overnight Guests and Athletic Facility Users

Members and guests staying at the Club or accessing its athletic facilities may wear informal clothing and shoes when passing through the lobby. They may access the front doors and elevators wearing informal apparel as long as it includes no prohibited items (see list on back panel), and must proceed directly to their destination. Members and guests wearing prohibited apparel must enter and exit the side entrance at 3 West 54<sup>th</sup> Street.

## Special Events

\*The following apparel is prohibited in the main areas of the Club House.

- Mini-skirts
- Athletic clothing
- Thongs/beach sandals
- Sneakers/athletic shoes

## Guide to Appropriate Apparel at THE UNIVERSITY CLUB







## We value your support in maintaining our time-honored dress code policy.

Sound judgment and good taste are expected throughout all areas of the Club. Kindly refer to the guidelines below.

Men are required to wear a suit jacket or sport coat, a collared dress shirt, and slacks.

Women are required to wear tailored clothing which includes suits, dresses, or skirts. Tailored slacks may also be worn if accompanied by a jacket, elegant sweater, scarf, or a tailored or beaded top.

### Exceptions

Individuals may wear informal clothing (i.e., no tie or jacket) when entering through the front doors or passing through the Club's lobby to access guest rooms or athletic facilities. Individuals wearing prohibited apparel\* must use the side entrance at 3 West 54<sup>th</sup> Street. *In either case, members and guests must proceed directly to their destination.*

### Men

Club attire for men includes:

- Suit jackets or sport coats
- Collared dress shirt
- Dress slacks
- Ties, cravats, or ascots for dinner in the Main Dining Room

### Women

Club attire for women includes:

- Suits
- Dresses
- Skirts
- Tailored Slacks paired with either a:
  - Top with jacket or elegant sweater or scarf
  - Beaded or tailored top



## QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE

### MAIN DINING ROOM/DWIGHT DINING ROOM

Suit jackets or sport coats and dress shirts are **required** at all times for men. Ties, ascots, or cravats are **required** for dinner in the Main Dining Room. Women should dress in comparable attire.

### TAP ROOM/BILLIARD ROOM/ 10<sup>TH</sup> FLOOR TERRACE

On weekdays, suit jackets or sport coats and dress shirts are **required**. On weekends, suit jackets and sport coats are not required and polo shirts may be worn. On the 10<sup>th</sup> Floor Terrace, suit jackets and sport coats are not required and squash whites are acceptable every day. Women should dress in comparable attire.

### ATHLETIC FACILITIES

Our athletic facilities have their own dress requirements. Please see the Fitness or Squash staff for details or consult the website.

### INFORMING GUESTS AND COMPLIANCE

Members are responsible for informing their guests regarding the dress code. Individuals not complying with our policies will be requested to change into appropriate attire. If they do not comply after being requested, they shall not be served and may be asked to leave the Club House.

The Club reserves the right, in its sole discretion, to determine on a case-by-case basis what is or is not appropriate attire, and in doing so, its objective shall be to preserve the ambiance of the Club House.
