

University Club Dress Code

Gentlemen: Dress trousers with suit jackets or sport coats and dress shirts are required. In addition, ties are required for dinner. Suit jackets and sport coats are not required on the 10th Floor Terrace. On weekends, collared polo shirts may be worn, and jackets are not required, in the Tap Room, Billiard Room, Television Room, and on the 10th Floor Terrace.

Ladies: The requirement is for suits, dresses or skirts. Tailored pants may be worn if paired with either a top with jacket, elegant sweater or scarf, or a beaded or tailored top.

The following clothing is **prohibited** in all public areas: **jeans and all denim apparel**, Capris, cargo pants, rompers, shorts, **leggings of any type**, T-shirts, sportswear, midriff tops, mini-skirts, athletic clothing, beach or thong sandals, sneakers, and athletic shoes.

Members and guests wearing prohibited apparel must use the 3 West 54th St. entrance to directly access or exit from the Club's athletic facilities and guest rooms.



University Club Electronic Device Policy

Cell phones and other digital devices should be silenced and put away upon entering the Club House. Handheld digital devices are not permitted in the Atrium.

Phone conversations and virtual connections are permitted in private rooms and phone booths only. Handheld electronic devices may be used in silent mode in the Douglas Reading Room, the Dwight Lounge, and the athletic facilities. Laptops may be used in silent mode in the Library and its adjoining areas.

The taking of photographs or videos and the streaming or broadcasting of images is not permitted in the public areas of the Club House without the prior permission of the House Committee Chair or the Chair's designee. Images may not be used for commercial purposes or be posted to any public forum, including public-facing social media, without prior written approval of the House Committee Chair or the Chair's designee.
